

ANNUAL REPORT - 2004

It is my pleasure to present, as Secretary General of the Association of Indian Universities, the Annual Report for the year 2004, at this the 79th Annual Meeting of the Association, being held at beautiful campus of University of North Bengal, Rajarammohunpur, District Darjeeling. Activities of the Association during the year 2004 are reported, in brief, below:

The Association in collaboration with the National Museum Institute of History of Art, Conservation and Museology, New Delhi organized a Roundtable on "**Problems and Perspectives of Higher Education in Jammu and Kashmir and North Eastern Region**" at National Museum, New Delhi on February 28-29, 2004. The Roundtable was inaugurated by Prof. K Venkatasubramanian, the then Member, Planning Commission. Prof. K Mohandas, President, AIU presided over the inaugural function. Vice Chancellors/Directors of University level Institutions in these regions, some former Vice Chancellors and heads of apex bodies participated. Recommendations of the Roundtable were circulated to all concerned departments for appropriate action thereon.

As an outcome of this roundtable, the Council of Architecture has come up with a proposal for setting up a School of Architecture in North Eastern Region. In this context a meeting of the Vice Chancellors of Universities in region will be held during the Annual Meeting.

The Association had organized a Roundtable on "University Management" for newly appointed Vice Chancellors at Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra on May 20-22, 2004. This activity has been re-started and the Association intends to continue it in future.

Membership

The Standing Committee of the Association at its 277th Meeting held on March 23, 2004, constituted a Committee to draw guidelines for granting admission to University level Institutions under the Chairmanship of Prof. K Mohandas, President, AIU and Director, Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute for Medical Sciences and Technology, Thiruvananthapuram with Prof. Vachaspati Upadhyaya, Vice Chancellor, Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeeth, New Delhi, Prof G C Saxena Vice Chancellor, Dr. B A University, Agra, Prof. Surabhi Banerjee, Vice Chancellor, Netaji Subhas Open University, Kolkata and the Secretary General, AIU as its member. The Committee at its meeting held on June 3, 2004 submitted its report which was considered and approved by the Standing Committee at its meeting held on September 28, 2004 at New Delhi. The process for evaluating the request of the Universities for membership of the Association has been initiated.

International Collaboration

Association in collaboration with the Australian High Commission in India, organized a Roundtable of Vice Chancellors on "**Financing of Higher Education**" on June 4-5, 2004, at Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute for Medical Sciences and Technology, Thiuruvananthapuram. The recommendations of this roundtable have been included in the agenda of the General Session for consideration.

A meeting of the AIU delegation under the Chairmanship of Prof. K Mohandas, President was held with the Australian delegation on August 31, 2004 wherein discussions were focused on mutual cooperation in the field of higher education between the two countries.

Evaluation Division

The Evaluation Division issued 355 Equivalence Certificate to foreign/nonresident Indian students. The division continued to provide expertise/assistance on the status of foreign qualifications to universities, Ministries of the Government of India, Union Public Service Commission, Indian Council of Cultural Relations, Medical Council of India and other central/ state Government agencies dealing with the nomination/ selection of Indian/foreign students intending to join Indian Universities.

Draft replies were provided to the Ministry of Human Resource Development for questions concerning higher education that were asked in the Parliament.

Visitors to AIU were provided information relating to equivalence of foreign degrees and on the status of courses offered by the professional institutions outside the purview of the universities. Over 5000 enquiries received through electronic mail/telephone and through post were attended and replied to.

During the year two-year Full time Postgraduate Diploma programmes in Management and allied disciplines of four professional institutions were considered out of which three have been granted equivalence to MBA degree after inspection of facilities by AIU Visiting Committee.

Student Information Services Division

The Division continued to serve the students, academics, parents, other stakeholders and visitors to AIU House by providing them information on the status of Indian institutions of higher education, professional bodies etc. and on the courses offered by Indian universities and other institutions recognised by statutory bodies like AICTE, NCTE and MCI. Approximately, 2000 written enquiries on the subject were also responded to.

The Division continued to update itself by screening the leading newspapers in respect of admission notifications on various courses issued by Universities and other Institutions from time to time in order to provide latest information to students and updating the Handbooks.

The SIS Division has revised and updated the 29th edition of 'Universities Handbook' and 30th edition was released in February 2004. The 6th edition of 'Handbook on Distance Education' has been revised and its 7th edition was released in August, 2004. Now the division is revising the 'Handbook on Computer Education' and (the revised edition) will be released in January/February, 2005.

The SIS Division looks after the activities of the International Education Cell of AIU. It keeps record of activities related to international students and promotes activities related to international education. It has compiled the data of international students in Indian universities for the year 2003-04 (University-wise and Country-wise).

Library and Documentation Division

The Library and Documentation Division brought out the Handbook on Library and Information Science and Selections from University News on Library and Information Science is under progress. The Library provides statistical and other related information to the University News.

Another important aspect of documentation services rendered by the Library pertains to The Annual Index to the University News. The index comprises of two parts – Subject and Author. The subject index is made up of three components, i.e. articles, convocation addresses and book reviews. The author index is, in fact, the name index in the dictionary format of the contributors of articles and book reviewers.

During the year 2004, 123 titles have been added to the AIU Library's collection. The library has received 150 periodicals (109 Indian and 41 foreign). Of these 37 were subscribed, 69 were received gratis and 44 received in exchange for 'University News'.

Around 2000 students and scholars (both from developed and developing countries), visited the library. About 5700 photocopies have been supplied to the scholars. Twenty requests were received for Inter-Library loan and 15 were serviced. Around 1100 telephonic queries were attended.

University News

The University News maintained its longstanding tradition of regularity of appearance in the year 2004 also. It has carved a niche for itself in the field of higher education in the country by maintaining richness, relevance and state-of-theart contents. The major developments in the University News during the year are:







Sports Division

The details of sporting activities of Inter University Sports Board of India organized during the year 2004, are given below:

1. Inter University Tournaments

The Inter University Tournaments constitute the main component of NSO Programmes implemented in universities and colleges. During the year 2004, Inter University Tournaments in 18 disciplines for men, 16 for women and 17 for both men and women were organized at 70 university centers throughout India, with a view to spread sport culture and broad-base sports in institutions of higher education for achieving excellence at National and International level competitions. The Inter University Tournaments proved to be a unique forum for talent search and grooming it on scientific lines. A total of 1,98,000 (approx) University Students participated in 87 Inter University competitions. The details are given as under:

This highly trained team received the "Award for being Most Talented and Young Outfit of the National Championship".

(d) 24th Open National Rowing (M&W) Championships

Indian Universities (Men & Women) teams participated in the Open National Rowing Championship(s) organized from February 28, 2004 to March 2, 2004 at Chandigarh. Indian Universities teams reached the "Semi-Final Stage" of the championships.

Ms. Gurpreet Kaur, Panjab University, Chandigarh was outstanding throughout and she was selected for National Team for participation in International events.

(e) Indian Universities Badminton (M&W) teams participated in Central Zone Badminton Championships – 2004.

The Association in collaboration with the National Foundation for Communal Harmony (NFCH) organised the Inter University National Essay Contest as a part of its continued efforts to promote national and emotional integration amongst the university youth, during September-October 2004, with the objective of encouraging original and innovative writing on Communal Harmony and National Integration.

Special Session of Students & Youth Parliament on HIV/AIDS

The Parliamentary Forum on HIV/AIDS organised a two-day programme on "Students and Youth Parliament - a special session on HIV/AIDS" on November 6-7, 2004, at New Delhi. The AIU was given responsibility to invite 600 university youth to participate in the programme. An Inter University National Debate on HIV/AIDS was also organised in University of Mumbai to select the best debaters to get intensive training and participate on the subject of HIV/AIDS in Delhi. Selected university cultural contingents were invited to present their items of Folk Dance, Group Dance, Skits and Debate on this occasion.
