Dear Vice Chancellor/Director,

The Governing Council of the Association at its Extraordinary Meeting held on September 30, 2011 and October 10, 2011 at Shimla and AIU House respectively considered the reports amongst others, the Committee constituted to suggest amendments in AIU Rules and Regulations and Bye-laws.

The Governing Council, approved amendments in AIU Rules and Regulations, as detailed in the enclosed Annexure "A" and recommended to submit the same to members of the Association in pursuance of AIU Rule 30, reproduced below:

*Whenever it appears to the Standing Committee (Governing Council) that it is advisable to amend any provision of the Rules & Regulations, it may submit the proposition to the members of the Association at least two months in advance of a General Body meeting. The proposition shall be considered by the Association at the said meeting and if approved will be incorporated in the Rules & Regulations. All the provisions of the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 (Punjab Amendment) Act, 1957 as extended to the Union Territory of Delhi will apply to this Association.*

The matter will be included in the Agenda of the Business Session, of the 86<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting, scheduled to be held on December 15-17, 2011 at Cochin University of Science and Technology, Kochi for consideration.
