**Subject: Ban on Athletes from Participation in National University Games for using drugs : 2014-15 onwards.**

Dear Sir/Madam,

Now-a-days, use of banned drugs (doping) by budding sportspersons has become a menace in the university sports too. Over a period of time, it is observed that athletes have been using drugs (doping) with the sole motive to enhance their performance for winning sporting competitions at any cost.

Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports established National Anti Doping Agency (NADA) as an autonomous body with the mandate to take all measures in collaboration with sports bodies and all other stakeholders to get rid of sports of this menace, creating clean and conducive environment for healthy competition in sports.

Accordingly, National Anti Doping Agency (NADA) collected/conducted doping samples of sportspersons during National University Games 2011-12 to 2013-14. It is shocking to note that some athletes/sportspersons have been found tested positive for consuming banned drugs, leading to adverse analytical findings and violation of Anti Doping Rules of NADA. Hence, the NADA punished the guilty sportspersons strictly in accordance with their existing rules and banned from participating Inter University Tournaments: 2014-15 onwards for the period as mentioned in the enclosed list. Further, it is suggested that promising university athletes/ sportspersons need to be educated and sensitized against harmful side-effects of doping/drugs on their physical and mental health in the long run. The youth is considered to be hope and future of Indian sports.

It is, therefore, requested that seminars, teaching sessions and workshops should be conducted with the help of NADA experts for creating awareness among athletes and coaches/trainers about the doping in sports so as to save the younger generation of sportspersons from the invisible dangers of drugs. The AIU would like to facilitate the process of organizing such seminars, if required.

It may please be noted that those sportspersons who are found guilty of using drugs have been included in the list of banned athletes and up-loaded on the AIU website: <http://www.aiuweb.org> for information of all stakeholders. Hence, they shall not be allowed to participate in Inter University Tournaments from 2014-15 onwards till the completion of period of ban imposed by the NADA or given clean chit by the NADA itself as the case may be. The performance details of the banned athletes shall also not be considered for the MAKA Trophy Award: 2013-14. A list of banned athletes is enclosed for ready reference.

**Subject: Ban on sportspersons from participation in university games for using drugs by NADA .**

Now-a-days use of banned drugs (doping) by the budding sportspersons has become a menace in university sports. The doping in sports is the complete antithesis of the noble spirit of sports. The athletes use banned drugs with the sole motive to enhance their sporting performance to win competitions at any cost. Doping not only destroys the health and well-being of the athletes, risking serious health consequences with deadly side-effects and eroding public confidence and respect.

Further, National Anti Doping Agency (NADA) collected/conducted doping samples of sportspersons during National University Games for the years: 2012-13 to 2013-14. After following due process and hearing their view point, some talented athletes/sportspersons have been banned from participating in National University Games on account of consuming banned drugs followed by adverse analytical findings with a view to make university sports drug free. The details are given below:-
