

Student Information Services

The Division keeps on updating the information by screening the leading newspapers in respect of admission notifications on various courses issued by universities and other institutions from time to time so that latest information could be provided to students and to make the Handbooks updated. A Handbook on Health Sciences Education (17th edition) was released in March 2009 which provide information to the aspiring students seeking admission to Health Sciences courses in MBBS, BDS, Pharmacy and Nursing. It also contains lists of homoeopathic, ayurvedic, unani, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, naturopathy and postgraduate institutions.

In fulfillment of its objectives 'to act as a service agency and a clearing house or information', the Association has established a Library and Documentation Centre. This is engaged in a two pronged programme of development. The first relates to strengthening its resources while the second aims at dissemination. In pursuance of these goals it has launched on an ambitions programme of collection development and evolving instruments to reach the information to maximum numbers. The total number of books in the library today stands 20,258. The Library is particularly strong in its collection of Reports and Documents, emanating from governments and noncommercial and highly specialized educational associations and organizations. The Annual Reports, Calendars, Handbooks, Acts of the different Universities and Supreme Court Judgment on Educational Matters also available in the Library, which are regularly in demand and consulted by numbers of users.

During the year 2009, the library received the following:

- 150 periodicals (109 Indian and 41 forein). Of these 37 were subscribed, 69 were received on complementary basis
- 44 received in exchange of 'UNIVERSITY NEWS'.
- Around 2825 students and scholars, visited the library during the year.
- 11,760 photocopies had been supplied to the scholars.
- 10 requests were received for Inter-Library loan and 12 were serviced during the year.
- Numerous telephone queries were attended during the year.

Sale of AIU Publications

The sale promotion of AIU publications is done through various exhibitions, dispatching of publicity materials and circulars to the Universities, Institutions, Indian Embassies abroad and Foreign Mission in India from time to time and whenever the books are released. Besides, as and when the new publications, reports, etc are published, the same are being dispatched to the Vice Chancellors/Directors of member Universities, dignitaries & Govt. officials on complementary basis. The total revenue owned by AIU, through Sales and Publications, advertisements and university news subscriptions during the year 2009 amounts to Rs. 96.94 lacs.

Book Exhibition

As a part of sale promotion, the AIU publications are being displayed at the venue of the 84th Annual General Meeting at the Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar. As per the past experience, there is every likelihood that we may have cash sales and advance booking of orders for our publications.

We regularly receive advertisements to be published in our journal - University News from our member universities, institutions, Govt. departments, booksellers and other parties on pre-payment and bill basis.

Subscriptions of University News

The print run of University News as of date is 7000 copies. The current number of paid subscribers is about 6045 and 731 copies are being sent on complementary basis to the Vice Chancellors/Directors and Registrars of member universities, Government officials and other important dignitaries/academics.

Monthly Pocket Planner

In addition to the above, Monthly Pocket Planners are being sent to the entitled persons, which include Vice Chancellors/Directors, Registrars of member universities and other dignitaries as per the mailing list maintained for this purpose in the Division.

Sports & Youth Affairs Activities

Sports

It is a matter of pride and honour that Inter University Sports Board of India (AIU) has been granted the status of National Sports Promotion Organisation (NSPO)

by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports on account of its meritorious services tor promoting sports at the grass root level in the universities and colleges in the country.

Inter-University Tournaments 2009

The conduct of National University Games constitute the main components of NSPO Scheme while promoting games and sports in university sector. During the year-2009, Inter-University Tournaments in 18 disciplines for men, 16 for women and 17 for both men and women were organized at 70 University centers throughout India, with a view to create sport-culture and broad base "youth sports" for achieving excellence at National and International sporting arena.

National University Games proved to be main platform for Talents Search and Talent Promotion on scientific lines and in a professional way for the purpose of throwing up sporting potential to feed the national stream and creating a large pool of talents with attainable and sustainable performance target:

Training of Indian Universities Cricket Team: 2009

During the Vizzy Trophy Cricket (M) Tournament - 2009, twenty (20) best Cricket Players were selected by the duly constituted Committee. The training of the Indian

Universities Cricket team was sponsored by the BCCI and organized at National Cricket Academy, Bangalore under guidance of the qualified Coaches, Trainers and Sports Scientists. As a result, the team reflected an improved performance in highly contested matches during Hemu Adhikari Trophy Tournament 2009 held at China Stadium, Bangalore.

The 24th Inter-University National Youth Festival sponsored by the Association of Indian Universities and the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India was hosted by Vidyasagar University, Midnapore in West Bengal during Jan 19 to 23, 2009. Invitations to participate in the National Youth Festival were extended to those universities, which secured first and second positions in various events of the earlier held Four Inter-University Zonal Youth Festivals. In all, Sixty Universities from all over India were invited; of which Fifty-Seven universities participated in the Youth Festival.

4th SAUFEST

Under the aegis of the AIU, Panjab University, Chandigarh organized the 4th South Asian Universities Youth Festival (SAUFEST) during February 12 to 16, 2009. Over 175 youth artistes from 22 South Asian Universities participated in the festival which included countries of Nepal, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Afghanistan, Bhutan and India. The ebullient youth artistes show cased their talents and respective cultures through music, theatre, fine-arts, folk art, heritage, debates, dances and paintings during the festival.

The 4th SAUFEST played a pivotal role in realizing the objective of the Festival, keeping in view the main theme of active collaboration and mutual understanding amongst the South Asian countries in educational, social, cultural and economic fields. The concept of the 4th SAUFEST has been conceptualized with the goal of bringing

our future generation from the South Asian countries on a common platform for sharing views, innovations and common ideas.

4th Inter-University National Yoga Camp

The 4th Inter-University National Yoga Camp was held during May 9-15, 2008 at Swami Vivekananda Yoga Anusandhana Samsthana, Bangalore under the auspices of AIU. The Camp was inaugurated by the Chief Guest, Prof. Sudha Murthy on May 9, 2008 during which Prof. Sureshwer Sharma (Ex Vice Chancellor, Jabalpur Univ.) was the Guest of Honour. The other dignitaries present on the occasion included Prof. H R Nagendra, Vice Chancellor of Swami Vivekananda Yoga Anusandhana Samsthana, Bangalore and Prof. NVC Swamy well-known Yoga Expert. The daily programmes comprised of Group Discussions which were facilitated by the renowned Yoga teachers. The programme incorporated Yogasans, Meditation, Kriya, Emotional Culture and Theory. Nineteen participants from four Universities participated in the Camp.

Finance

The Finance Committee of the Association at its meeting held on September 30, 2009 considered and approved the revised budget estimates for 2009-10 and budget estimates for 2010-11.

The audited accounts of the Association and AIU PF Trust from M/s. K N Goyal & Co, Chartered Accountants which include balance sheet, income and expenditure account, receipt and payment account were also approved in the Finance Committee Meeting. These will be placed before the forthcoming General Body Meeting for consideration.

The reply received from the Govt. auditors with regard to settlement of audit paras of the Audit Inspection Report for the FY 2006-07 was considered in the FC meeting held on 13.7.09. A Sub-Committee was constituted by the FC to look into the details of unsettled audit paras. The Sub-Committee met on 7.8.09 and submitted its report for the consideration of Standing Committee. The replies were approved by the SC in its meeting held on 1.10.2009.

Grants Received

- a. Rs.1.50 crore adhoc grant is received from Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports for MAKA Trophy vide letter No.F.3-1/2009-SP-I dated 15th October 2009.
- b. The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt of India, has sanctioned a grant of Rs.55.00 lacs under Plan Grand and Rs. 32.00 lacs under Non Plan

- Grant, out of which we have received the 1st and 2nd Installment of Plan and Non Plan Grant of Rs.27.50 lacs and Rs. 16.00 lacs respectively till September 2009.
- c. A Grant of Rs.55.18 lacs has been sanctioned by the Ministry of YA & Sports for Youth Affairs activities.

Special Initiatives

After assuming the office of the Secretary General on 20 July 2009, the Secretary General made following efforts to yield the aims of NSPO and following proposal were submitted:

- a. Consequent upon the grant of Status of National Sports Promotion Organization (NSPO) to the AIU, a Long Term development Plan (LTDP) 2009-2012 is submitted to the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports and Sports Authority of India (SAI).
- b. Estimated Budget for the year 2009-2010 for Rs.10.35 crores is submitted to the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports and Sports Authority of India (SAI) for approval and release of 75% advance for making adequate necessary arrangements vide letter No. No.S/NSPO/SG/2009 dated 30.7.2009. The matter is under active consideration by the expert committee of the SAI.
- c. A revised criteria for the Award of MAKA Trophy from 2009-2010 onward is submitted to the Hon'ble Union Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports for his kind approval.
- d. The proposed criteria for the award of MAKA Trophy 2009-2010 is placed on the AIU Website for the information of all stake holders and maintaining absolute transparency.
- e. Consequent upon the assurance of BCCI in the meeting held on 9.9.2009 at Bombay, a proposal with estimated cost of Rs. 10.00 crores for creating infrastructure for promotion of Cricket in the universities established in the Hilly, Rural and Tribal Areas in India is submitted to the President, BCCI vide letter No. SG/BCCI/infra/2009-10 dated 9.9.2009 for consideration.
- f. For renovation of AIU building, a proposal with detailed estimate is submitted to Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India for one time financial assistance of Rs.5.00 crores.
- g. A proposal was submitted to Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India, to provide financial assistance for conducting Student Research Convention.

- h. A request was made to the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India to approve grant for filling up sanctioned posts in the Research Division.
- i. Efforts have been made for recovery of outstanding bills of advertisement and publications.
- j. Efforts are also been made for settlement of Government Audit Paras relating to outstanding, utilization certificates, purchase of paper and unsold publications.

Achievements

- a. One post of Assistant Secretary (Sports) @ basic pay of Rs.5500/- (pre-revised) has been created by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports for AIU vide their letter No. F.3-1/2009-SP.I dated 27th October, 2009.
- b. A balance grant of Rs.8.44 lacs has been received from Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports for the year 2006-07 vide their letter No.F.3-2/2006/SP.I dated 13.8.2009. A proposal has been submitted to the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports to approve and sanction for the expenditure incurred to organize MAKA Trophy during the year 2007-08 and 2008-09 respectively.
- c. The recommendations of the Sixth Pay Commission for Central Govt. Employees have also been implemented for AIU employees w.e.f. 1.1.2006 as per Bye-law 2.1. Accordingly, the 2nd installment of 60% arrears were released in favour of AIU staff members.
- d. Pay scales and promotion of pending cases of AIU employees were approved by Staff Affairs and SC on 30.9.2009 and 1.10.2009 respectively.
- Women's University, Mumbai, secured the second position in the National Student Research Convention 2009 (held at Bengal Engineering and Science University, Howrah) under the category of Basic Sciences has been selected for a scholarship from Utrecht University in Netherlands for three months from December 1, 2009 to March 1, 2010 for her project "Isolation and Chemical Characterization of Catechin A Potential Bio-marker with Antioxidant Activity". The Utrecht University short stay fellowship is a full grant that will cover for the visit to Utrecht University (including ticket, visa, health and liability insurance, accommodation and monthly allowance).
- f. Invitation received from Notre Dame University Louaize to attend the IAU 2009 Conference on "The Role of Higher Education in Fostering the Culture of Dialogue and Understanding" on November 4-6, 2009 at Lebanon.

g. Capacity Building Programme for AIU staff: The Association of Indian Universities organized a training programme for its staff members. The agency InfoEdge Solutions imparted the training for a duration of three weeks from September 14-29, 2009 and from October 20-29, 2009. The Training programme covered three major areas targeted for different groups. The course covered Computer Training, Office Procedure and Management and Multi Skill Development Training. The Staff members received certificates for the training from the Secretary General, AIU.

I take this opportunity to express my gratitude to Dr. M D Tiwari, President, Dr P T Chande, Vice President, members of the Standing Committee and Vice Chancellors/Directors of all member Universities/Institutions for their continued support, guidance, cooperation and active participation in the activities of the Association. I thank my colleagues in AIU House for their dedication and zeal to carry out all the activities of AIU effectively.






