INAUGURAL SESSION

Dr. Ranoj Pegu, Hon'ble Minister of Education, Govt. of Assam

Shri Ranoj Pegu is Hon'ble Minister of Education, Welfare of Plain tribes Backward Classes. A seasoned Indian Politician and a Member of the Legislative Assembly of Assam from Dhemaji. Dr. Pegu's contribution to the development of Assam is commendable. A Medical Practitioner by Profession, Dr. Pegu joined politics at a very young age and became one of the most popular leaders in Assam. His enormous abilities have carved a niche for him in politics and enabled him to achieve important portfolios.

Shri Jayanta Malla Baruah, Hon'ble Minister Skill Development Employment & Entrepreneurship etc, Govt of Assam

Shri. Jayanta Malla Baruah currently the Cabinet Minister in the Government of Assam and holds the portfolio of Public Health Engineering, Skill, Employment & Entrepreneurship and Tourism. Prior to this he was the Political Secretary to the Chief Minister of Assam. In 2017, he was appointed the Chairman of the Assam Tourism Development Corporation. During his tenure as Chairman of ATDC he drew attention by holding the Filmfare award show in Assam, the first time that the show was held outside Mumbai in its 65-year history.

Prof. (Dr.) Nani Gopal Mahanta, Education Adviser, Govt of Assam

Prof. Nani Gopal Mahanta is currently the Education Adviser to the Govt of Assam. Prof. Mahanta is also the Head of the Department of Political Science and Director, Global Studies Centre, at Gauhati University. Formerly he was the Coordinator, Peace and Conflict Studies, a UGC Innovative project from 2004-2009 at the Gauhati University. His research interest includes issues of Peace and Conflict Resolution, Human Development and Security, Insurgency, Ethnicity and Identity Politics. He was selected as the Rotary World Peace Fellow at the University of California, Berkeley from 2002-2004. As a World Peace fellow, he travelled to various parts of the world including Europe and South Asia for his internship and empirical work. Prof Mahanta was a visiting fellow to International Peace Research Institute (PRIO), Norway, Oslo. He is also the president of North East India Political Science Association (NEIPSA).

Shri Atul Kothari, National Secretary, Shiksha Sanskriti Utthan Nyas

Shri Atul Kothari is the Secretary, Shiksha Sanskriti Utthan Nyas. He is one of the founders of 'Shiksha Bachao Andolan Samiti' and the Founder Joint Secretary of 'Shiksha Sanskriti Utthan Nyas'. He was the National General Secretary and National Joint Organising Secretary of 'Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad' (ABVP). Shri Kothari authored several books and articles, the prominent ones include Bharatiya Shiksha: Rashtriya Sankalpana; Shiksha ki Swayattata; Uchch Shiksha: Bharatiya Drishti. He organised more than 3000 workshops and Seminars across the country on character building and holistic development. He is a recipient of the citation of honour by Sahitya Mandal for his distinctive contribution. He founded Bharatiya Bhasha Manch and Bharatiya Bhasha Abhiyan for the promotion of Indian languages. A great thinker and orator Shri Kothari addressed the World Assembly of Religions in the US in 2015.

Dr. Ashok Kumar Pansari, Chancellor, The Assam Royal Global University

Dr. Ashok Kumar Pansari is the Founder and Chancellor of The Assam Royal Global University. A great Social Worker and Edupreneur Dr Pansari realized his vision to set up an educational institute that would give the North-East a world-class opportunity to curb the exodus of students by setting up The Royal Group of Institutions, Royal Global School, and Delhi Public School in Assam. He is a TED speaker and author of the titles Baaton Baaton Mein, Baatein Santon va Granthon ki which were translated into other languages. He also established a media house named Purvoday Publications Private Ltd. at Guwahati which publishes Hindi Daily, "Dainik Purvoday". As a service to Society, he completed projects like Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana and initiated services like Royal Anna Seva, Swasthya Seva and Vastra Seva for the welfare of the disadvantaged.

He also served Harcourt Buttler Technical University, Kanpur; Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti Language University, Lucknow; Rajasthan Technical University, Kota; and Doctor Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Agra Harcourt Buttler Technical University, Kanpur; Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti Language University, Lucknow; Rajasthan Technical University, Kota; and Doctor Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Agra as Vice Chancellor in additional charge.
