Minutes of Scrutiny Committee Meeting for the Award of MAKA Trophy for the year 2015-16

A meeting of Scrutiny Committee constituted by the Competent Authority for the award of MAKA Trophy for the year 2015-16 was held on August 05, 2016 at 11.00 AM in the Conference Room, 4th Floor, Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi-110002. The following members attended the meeting:-

- a) At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all the members of the committee and representatives of the contesting universities for sparing their valuable time to attend the meeting for presentation of their point of view on self-calculated marks claimed by each contesting university.
- b) A brief background of the prestigious MAKA Trophy was also explained. The Prominent parameters for award and calculation of marks included in existing criteria approved by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports were also deliberated. The details are given below:-
- Consideration of Certificates of Merit issued by National Sports Federations recognized by Indian Olympic Association (IOA) and Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports only.
 - No allocation of marks for claiming sporting performance in Junior Category tournaments.
 - Deduction of 20 % marks from the total score of the university for submitting false certificate with wrong claim.
 - Deduction of 10 % marks from the total marks of the university whose complaints are found baseless and wrong.
 - Deduction of 5% marks from the total score of the university each case of dope positive.
- c) The representatives of contesting universities were invited for Power-Point Presentation of self-calculated credentials and claims of sporting performance of their athletes/teams for the year 2015-16 before the Scrutiny Committee in alphabetical order, turn by turn, followed by detailed discussion and interaction for clarification of certain queries raised by the contesting universities, with a view to maintain absolute transparency. Accordingly, issues raised during the discussion were clarified then and there, to the satisfaction of all the stakeholders.

After due deliberations and clarifications on various issues related to the award of the MAKA Trophy, the scrutinu committee taken the following decisions

1. GNDU, Amritsar claimed 325 marks in **A2 Category tournament** in Sultan Azlan Shah Cup 2016. After due verification, it was found that tournament is not included/mentioned in A2 Category. Hence, marks/points cannot be awarded to the university. Accordingly, 325 marks were deducted in accordance with the existing criteria for the award of MAKA Trophy.

Further, GNDU, Amritsar claimed 125 points for sporting performance of their athletes/teams in 56th National Inter State Sr. Athletics Championship in **B1 and B2 category tournaments**. After due verification, it was found/observed that the championship (Sr.No.29 of B1 and Sr.No15 of B2) is not conducted within the stipulated period such as from July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016 as per existing Rule No.IX (15) of the AIU handbook. Hence, 125 marks were deducted. Further, 20% of the total score were also be deducted in accordance with the relevant clause No.3 (ii) of criteria approved by Sports Ministry for wrong claims and submitting a false certificate for MAKA Trophy award.

2. Kurukshetra University claimed 500 marks for sporting performance of their athletes/teams in **A3 Categories tournaments**. The disciplines of Wrestling and Judo are "individual sports" whereas the university claimed marks for "Team Sports". Hence, 500 marks cannot be awarded.

Further, Kurukshetra University also claimed 325 marks in **C1 (Sr.No 15) and C2 (Sr.No 20 & 21) category tournaments**. The discipline of Handball in C1 category tournaments is included in the category of "Others sports", whereas university claimed the marks for **Priority Sports** and the disciplines of Power-lifting and Best Physique in C2 category tournaments are included in the category of "Others sports" where as university claimed the marks for **General category**. Hence, 325 marks cannot be awarded in accordance with the existing criteria for the award of MAKA Trophy. Further, 20% of the total score shall also be deducted in accordance with the relevant clause No.3 (ii) of criteria approved by Sports Ministry for wrong claims.

3. Punjabi University, Patiala claimed 500 marks for winning All India Inter University American (M) Football Tournament in **C1 Category Tournaments**. The discipline of American Football is not included in the list of Priority Sports approved by Sports Ministry. Hence, 500 marks cannot be awarded. Further, 20% of the marks were also deducted from the total score in accordance with the relevant clause No.3 (ii) of criteria approved by Sports Ministry for wrong claim.






