

**Faculty Development Programme (FDP)**  
**Delving Deep into Teaching-Learning Process**

**November 28-December 02, 2023**

FDP was organized on “Delving Deep into Teaching Learning Process”, from Nov. 28-Dec. 2, 2023. Thirty-Two participants got registered for the program. All the participants were teachers from different disciplines. The program was designed to empower teachers with enhanced skills, fostering improved connections, management, and teaching approaches to ensure comprehensive learning and benefits for all students. Its objective was to familiarize teachers with the intricacies of the Teaching-Learning Process.

***DAY-1 Nov 28, 2023 - Inauguration and How aware are we about Teaching as a profession.***

To start the first session, an attempt was made to have an idea about their thought process about their profession. All the participants were requested to answer 25 questions in google form. The link for the questions was shared by Hasiba Salihi. For completion of the questionnaire 20 minutes were given to the teachers. After completion of the questionnaire, all the questions thoroughly were discussed by Dr. Indu Rihani.

The Inaugural Session, conducted on November 28, 2023, at 3:30 pm, was graced by esteemed dignitaries including Dr. Ashoo Khosla, Chief Learning Officer at Shoolini University, Dr. Indu Rihani, Professor in Education at the School of Liberal Arts, Dr. Shubra Mishra, Assistant Professor in Mathematics, Shoolini University, and Ms. Hasiba Salihi, Research & Teaching Associate, Shoolini University.
