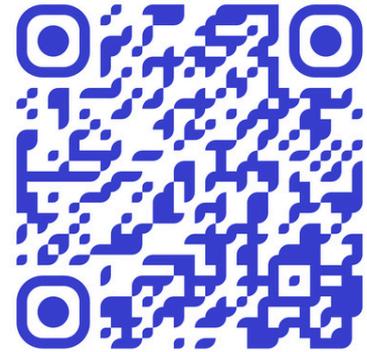

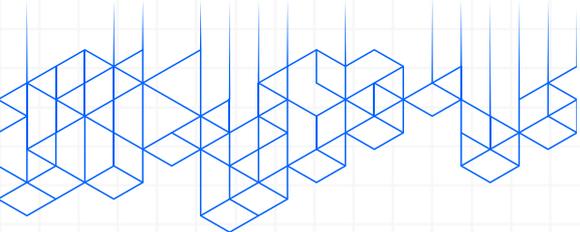

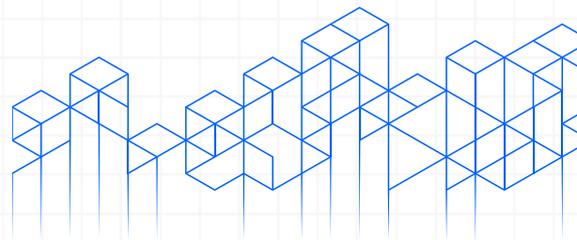
ABOUT THE ASSOCIATION OF INDIAN UNIVERSITIES (AIU)

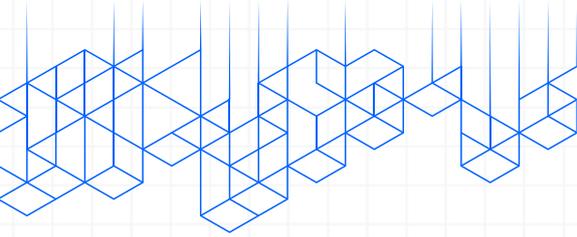

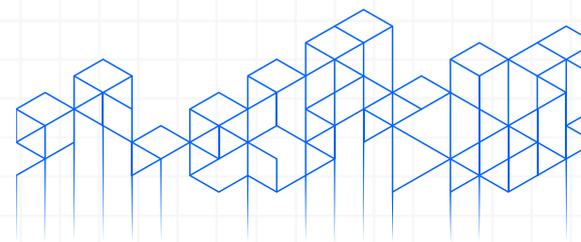

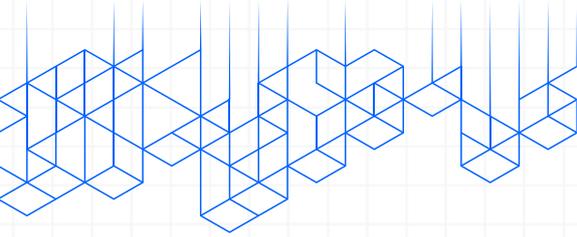
